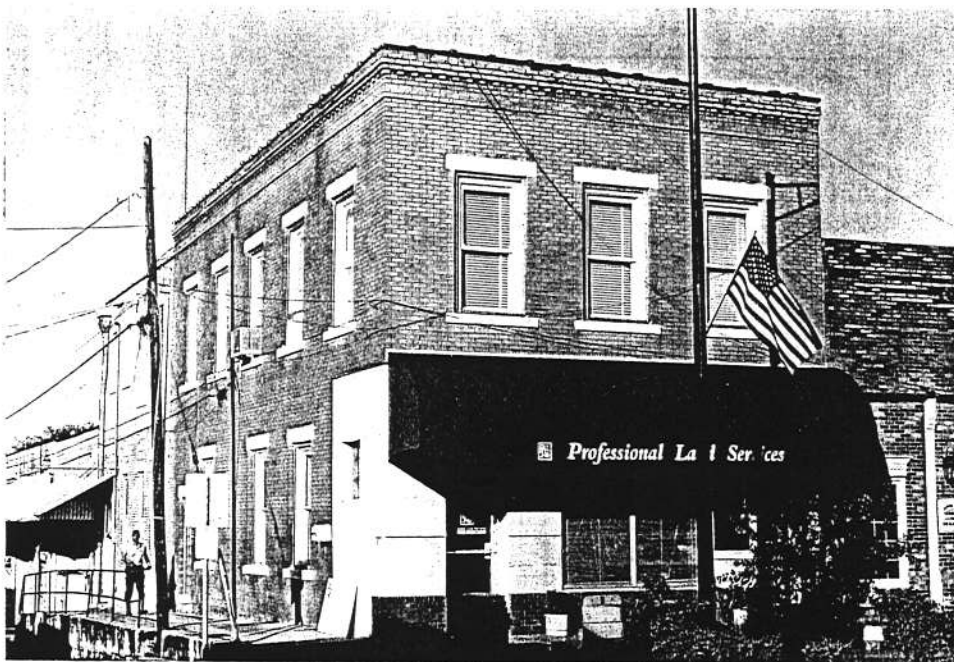

Two-story, brick, commercial building with maroon tinted mortar and a flat parapet with metal cap. Cornice consists of corbelled and dentilled stringcourse. The façade (E) has 3 windows in upper story, each with concrete lintel and sills. There are 5 identical windows on S elevation. Cloth awning shelters storefront on E, which has been remodelled. Original wrapped around to 1st bay of S elevation, now has been sided with Dryvet or cut stone. There are 2 glazed-metal doors at either corner that flank the centered paired metal-frame windows with a red, brick bulkhead.

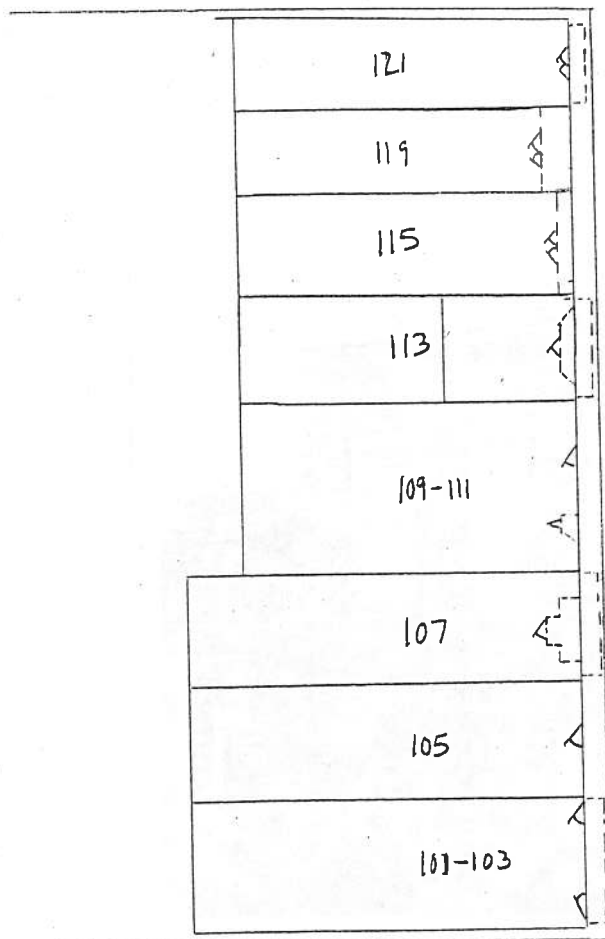
