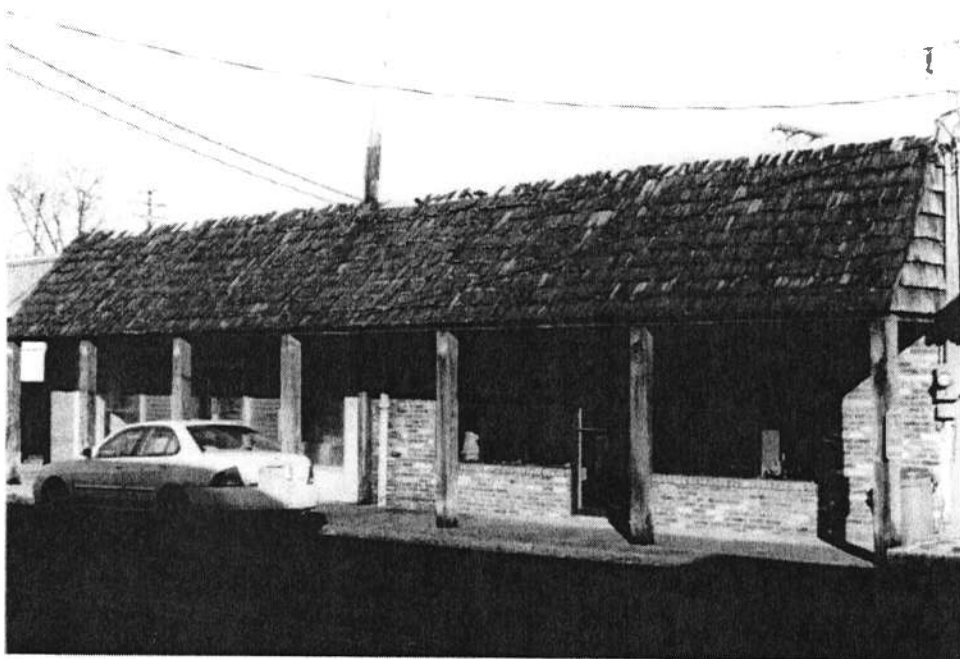

The right side has a single-leaf, glazed-metal door, which is flanked by a metal frame plate-glass window.

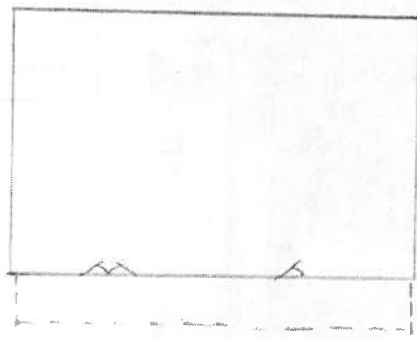
