Two-story, stucco commercial building with a flat parapet with tile or metal coping. The building has a canted corner and the probable original entrance has been enclosed. The façade (N) has 3 bays in 2nd story, each with a 1/1 wood-frame, square-headed window in a segmental arch opening, with a wood sill. The storefront area (c.1990s) has a shallow pent roof with dentilled cornice supported on original cast iron piers and pilasters featuring panelled sides and rosette decorations. Glazed-metal door and fixed plate-glass window fill the storefront. Side elevation (W) has stepped parapet, stuccoed chimneys and a 1/1 wood-frame window. Rear storefront has been rebricked.

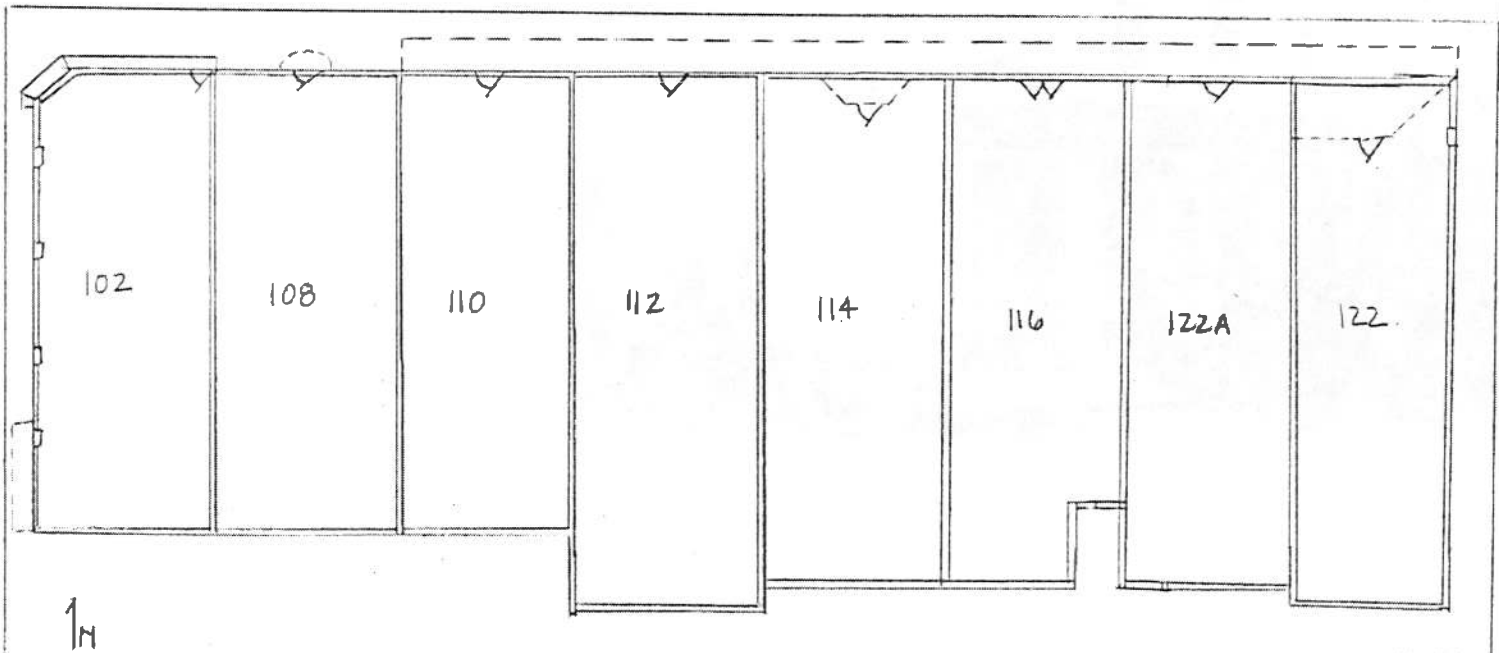
