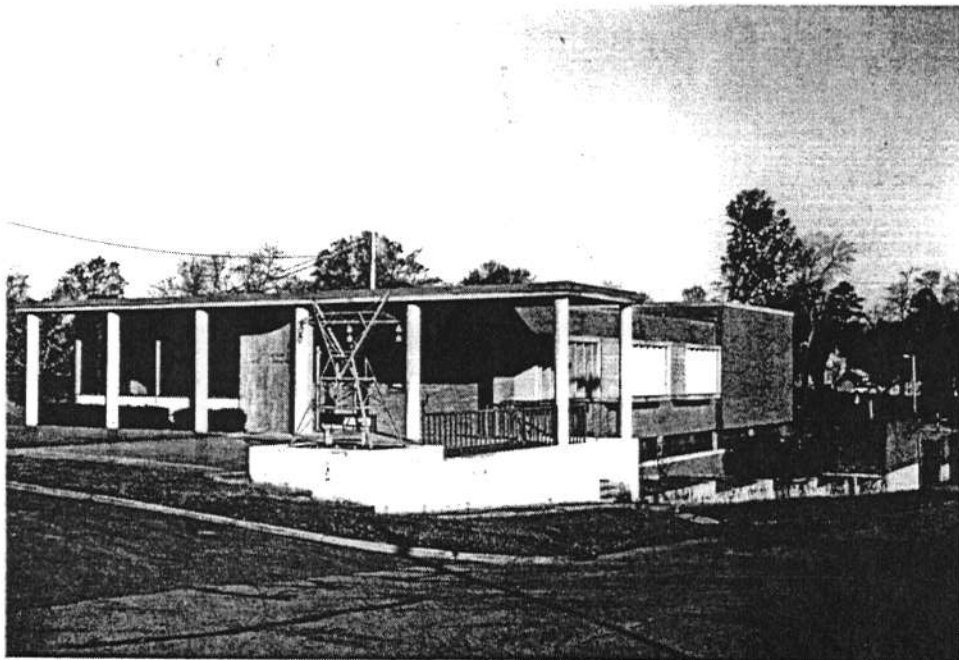

Brief Description:

One-story, tan, rough-faced Roman brick office building with a flat parapet on a concrete foundation. The façade (S) features a band of aluminum-frame, plate-glass windows to the left, wrapping around to the W elevation, a curved marble accent to the right of center and a recessed, Roman brick wall to the far right. The entrance is a 2-leaf, glazed, metal door with a 1-light transom, which is behind curved marble features. A full-width, but shallow, colonnaded porch stretches to the east, past the east wall, with a metal balustrade. The windows on the E elevation, main level, are aluminum-frame with large moveable, vertical, aluminum louvers. While the lower windows are 12-light, in a band stretching the length of the E elevation.

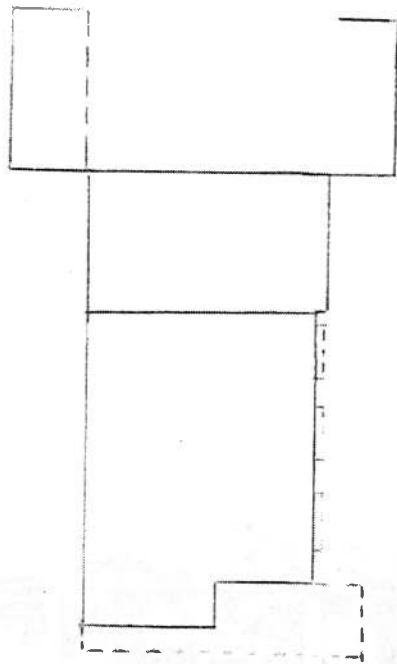
