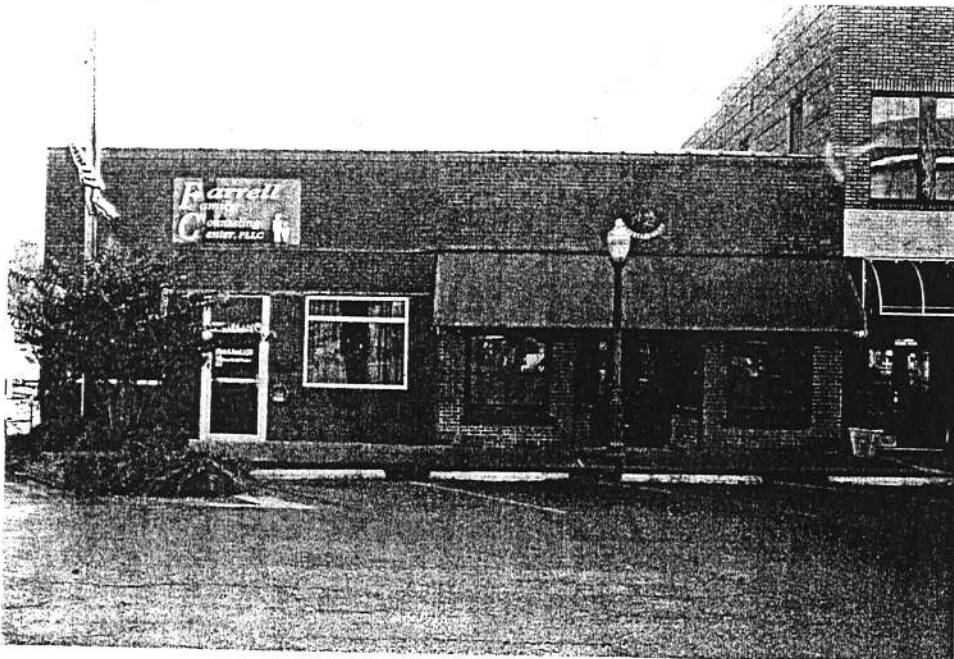

Brief Description:

One-story, brick commercial building (6-course common bond) with flat parapet topped with metal coping. Building contains two storefronts, with the left store being painted on the façade (W). Left bay's awning has been removed and storefront completely remodelled with a glazed metal door at the center, flanked by aluminum-frame plate-glass windows. Right bay's storefront is sheltered by a pent cloth awning and retains its original (or a historic) features—a central recessed entrance flanked by paired 4-light wood-frame windows with 2-light transoms. Entrance is a double-leaf glazed wood door with a 4-light transom and is flanked on the angled walls by two 1/1 wood-framed DHS. Beadboard ceiling in the entrance area. Building slopes to the rear, creating a basement,
