One-story, wide-clapboard with a side-gable roof of tan, asphalt shingles on a stucco foundation. A front-facing gable projects to form a vestibule with a round-arch entry, while the right side extends downward to include a front-facing, brick chimney, which has been cut off at the roof line. The façade (S) has asymmetrical fenestration with paired windows to the far left, an 8-light and 1-panel wood door in the vestibule and 2 single windows to the right. All windows are 6/6 wood-frame. The building has shallow, boxed eaves.

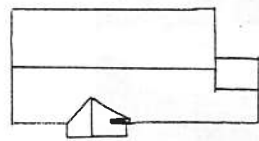
