Two-story, brick commercial building with a flat parapet and concrete cap and a 2-course sawtooth cornice. Second story has 2 paired windows that are infilled with fixed-glass with rowlock sills. Transom area has been bricked. Large cast iron piers are at the corners of the storefront and small cast iron pilasters are in antis, connected with iron step. Storefront has been recessed and consists of center double-leaf glazed, wood door with a 2-light transom flanked by a plate-glass window with a 2-light transom.

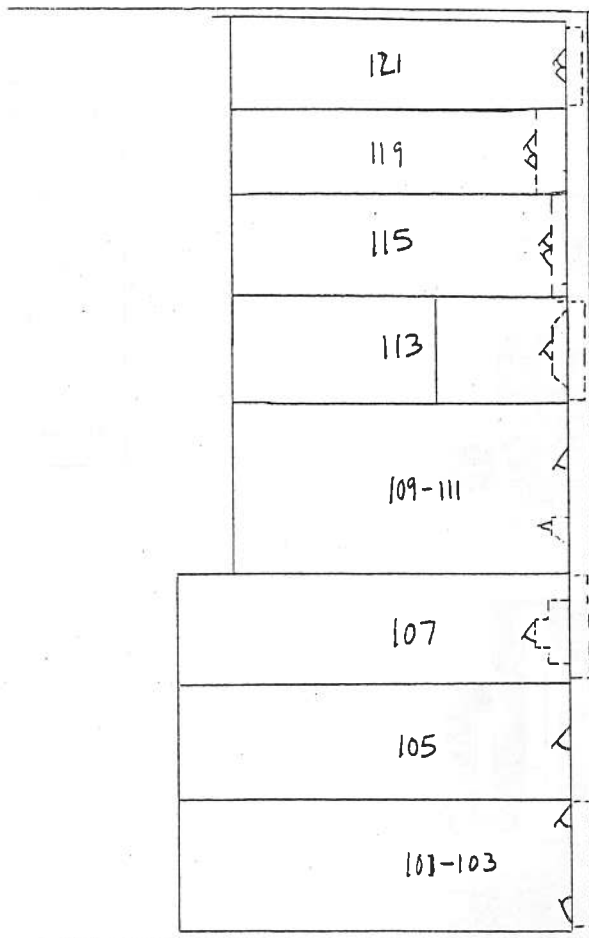
