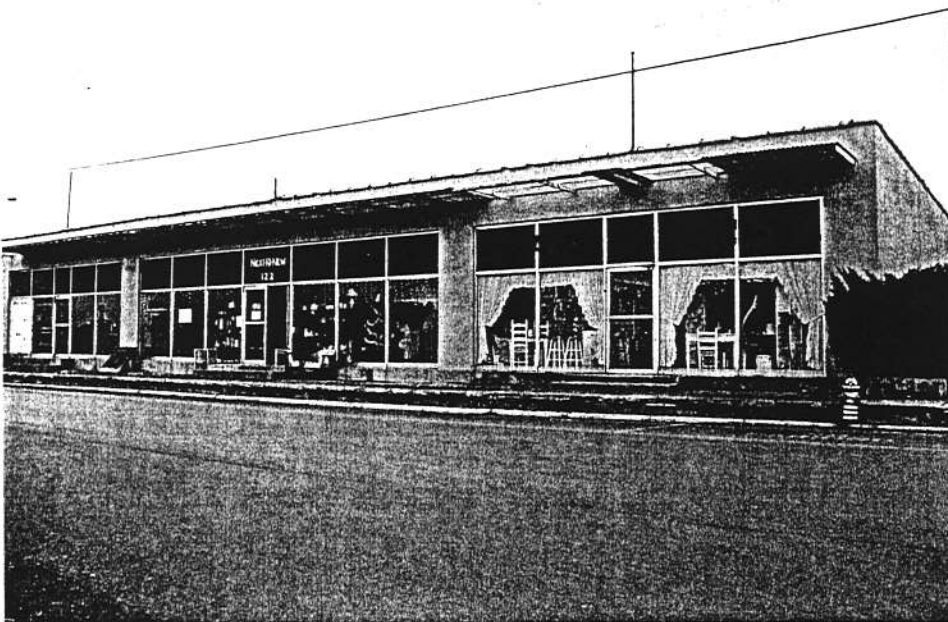
Brief Description:
