One-story, painted concrete block office/warehouse with a flat parapet. The building has 2 façade on the S & E, facing the street and RR tracks respectively. The building has a glazed-metal door sheltered by a pent, metal awning and a plate-glass storefront window.

Corrugated metal warehouse with a gable roof of standing-seam metal and shed roofs on the E & W elevations. There are no eaves. The entry porch on the NE side is along the RR tracks with a 3-panel wood door on the N facing wall and a 3-panel wood door on the E facing wall. There are large openings on the E elevation and a 6-light and 6/6 wood-frame breeze window on the W elevation. An interior brick chimney is in the NE corner.

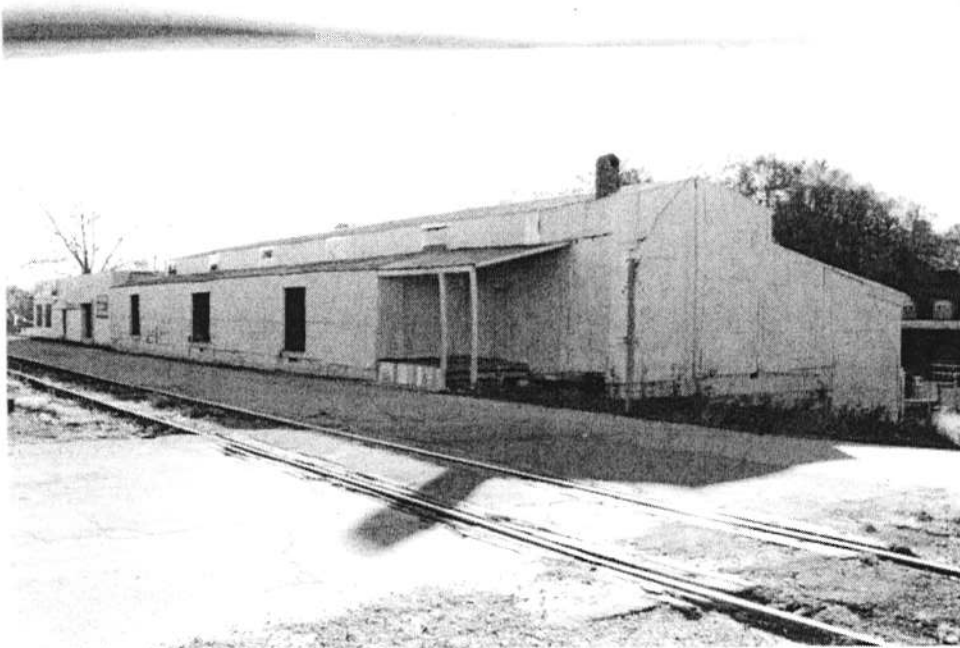
