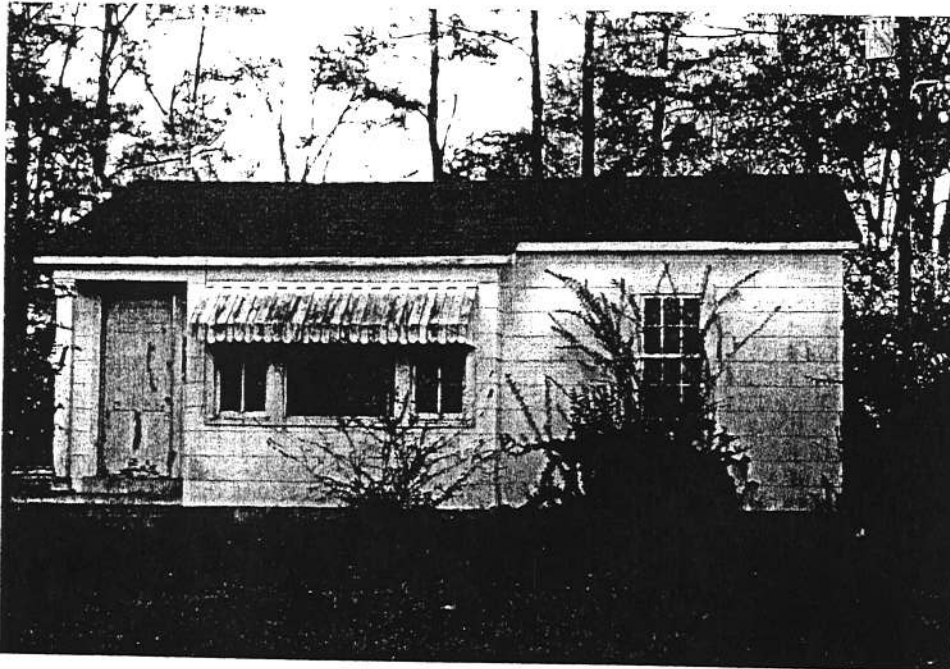

One-story, asbestos shingle sided with a side-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a poured concrete foundation. The façade (W) has 3 asymmetrical bays consisting of a 6-panel, replacement door to the far L under the undercut porch on boxed columns, a cottage window with 4/4 wood-frame windows flanking in the 2nd bay. Recessed to the R of this is a 6/6 wood-frame window. There are shallow, boxed eaves and a rectangular louvered vent in the gable end.

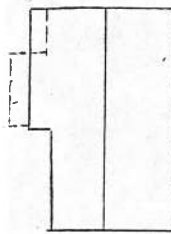
