A central glazed metal door is recessed between two aluminum-frame showcase areas. Turquoise panels also cover the transom area above the awning.

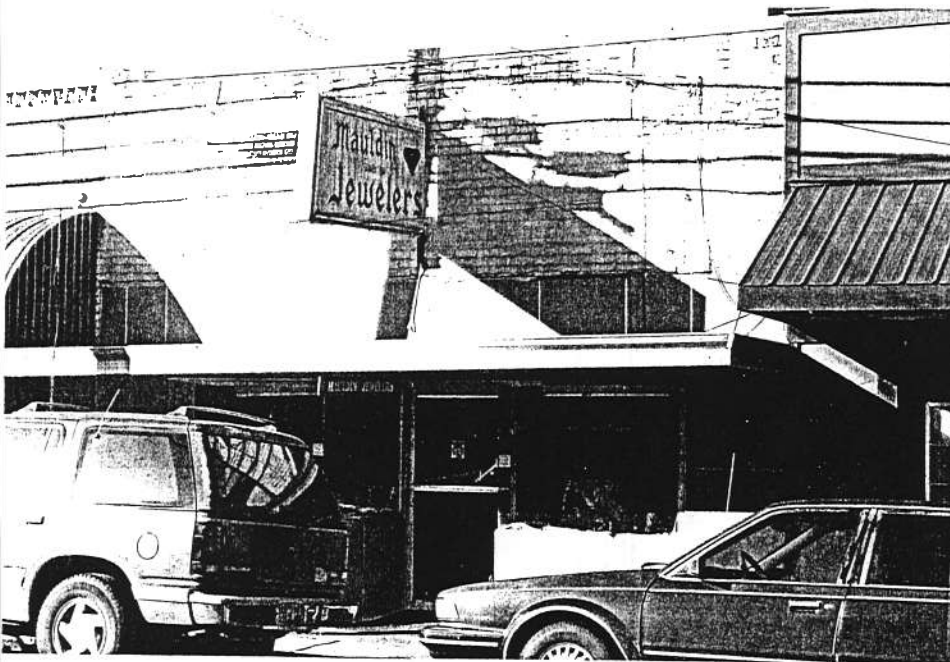

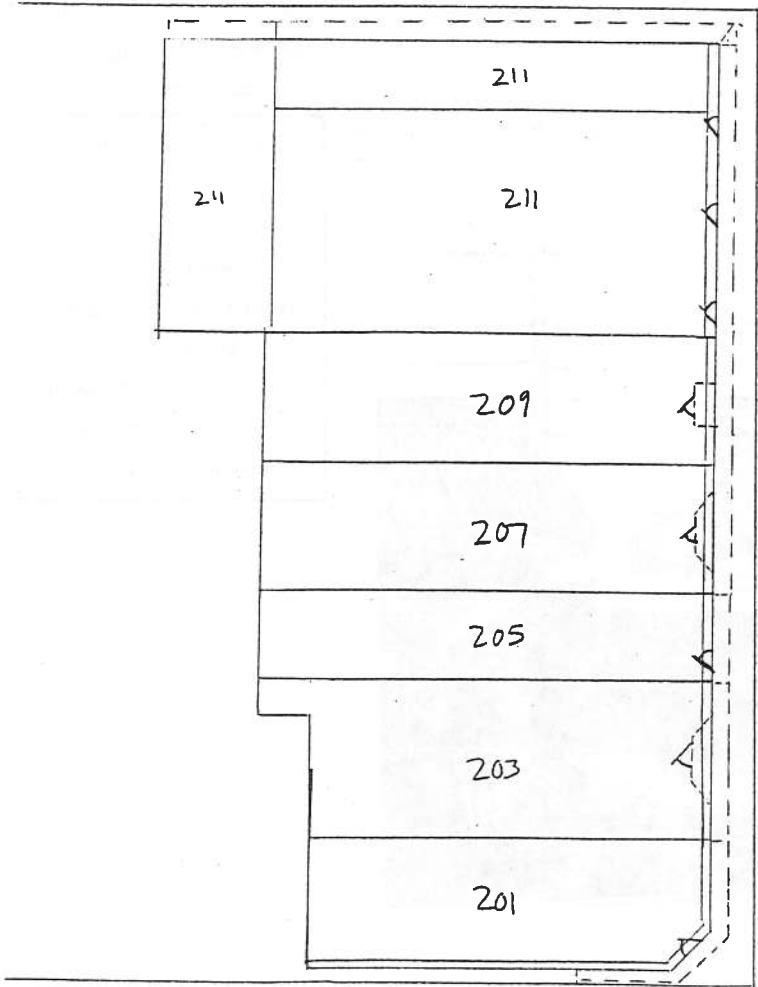
