One-and-a-half story, textured brick with a cross-gable of asphalt shingles on a textured brick foundation. There are shallow, boxed eaves and a soldier cornice. A front-facing gable is to the far L on the S façade with 2/2 (horizontal) wood-frame window in the gable end. The façade has 3 symmetrical bays that consist of a centered entrance, which is flanked by two, 2/2 wood-frame windows. The entrance to the house is on the E and W elevation. The W entrance, which is a 6-panel door, has the original shed awning on curved, triangular, knee braces. There is no awning over the E elevation.

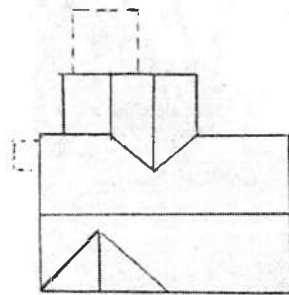
