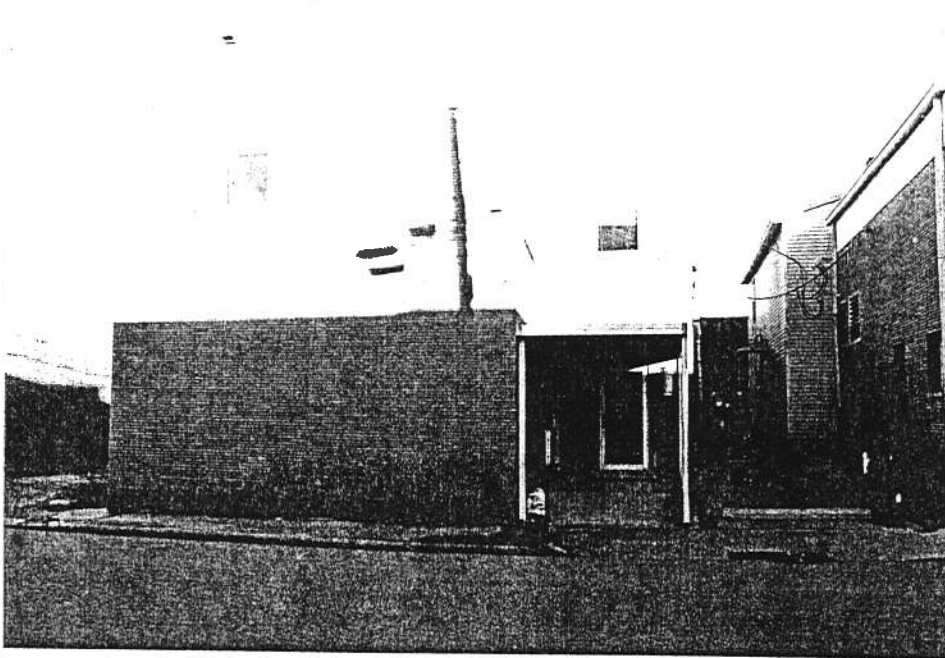

Brief Description:

Two-story, Roman-brick office building, apparently built as a subsidiary building to the Peoples Bank building facing E.Spring Street, as it has same features and building materials. Flat parapet is topped by a metal cornice. Entrance area is recessed on the W façade and consists of a glazed-metal door on E wall and a glazed-metal door on S wall. Flat metal awning shelters the entrances.
