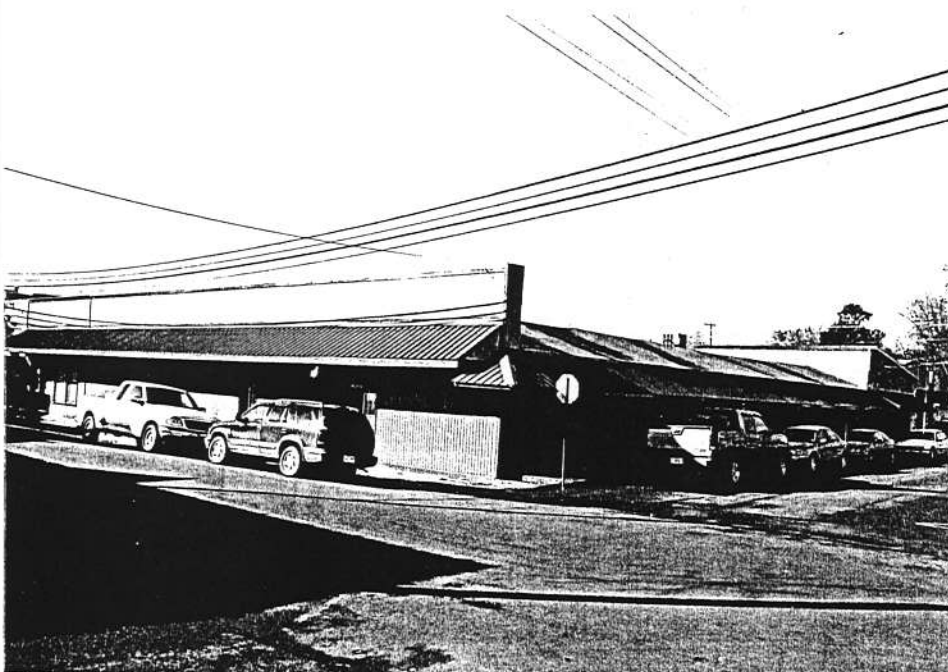
Brief Description:

One-story, Dryvet commercial building on corner lot, with gable or truncated gable roof of asphalt shingles behind flat parapet. Pent metal awning shelters both E façade and N elevation, which is now the entrance to the building. E façade is asymmetrically fenestrated with 9-light, 2-panel modern doors and plate-glass windows. Storefront is sided in wood.

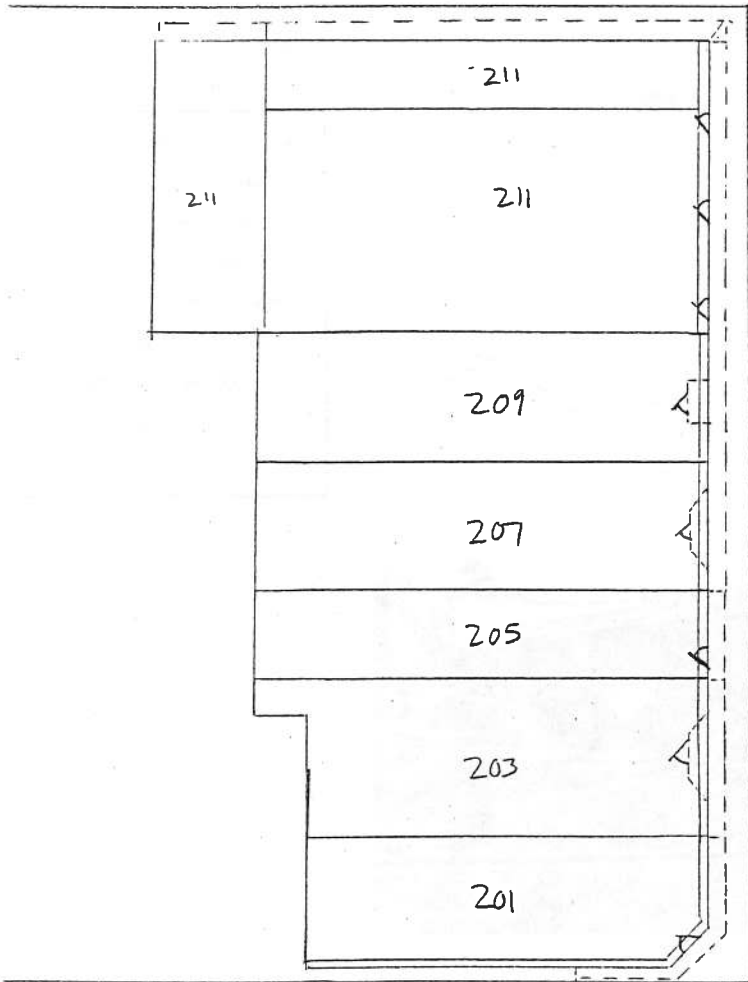
