Brief Description:

One-story, brick with cross-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a slab foundation. A front-gable entrance is at the far L on the N façade, pedimented with flush siding and a semi-circular louvered vent in the gable-end. A shallow, flat, portico with wood columns and corresponding pilasters, supporting the entablature frames the entrance, which consists of a 2-leaf, 3-panel wood door with an 8-light transom. To the R of the entrance area, a recessed wall area stretches 6 bays with the second bay being a recessed secondary entrance. The cornice on the recessed façade is narrower than that on the front-gable section. There are shallow, boxed eaves.
