One-and-a-half story, brick church with a front-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a slab foundation. A stepped, front-facing gable forms a 2-story porch on the S façade supported by metal, fluted columns. There is stucco in the gable end. A 2-leaf, raised-panel, wood door with a broken pediment cornice is under the porch. Flanking the porch are 2, round-arch, multi-light, wood-frame windows with louvered, 9-light sash and rowlock sills. There are identical windows on the E and W elevations. A wooden steeple tower rises with fluted and unfluted pilasters to a Presbyterian symbol at the top. There is a large gabled carport to the rear on the N elevation.

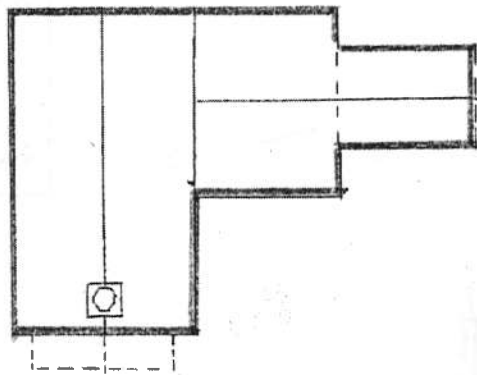
