Brief Description:

One-story, scored brick church with a front-gable and hip of standing-seam metal on a stucco foundation. There are wide, boxed eaves. A stepped gable projects on the façade and is pedimented with rough stucco and a louvered vent in the gable end, with fluted, Doric columns supporting the entablature and framed on the façade (W) by 2 brick pilasters. Under the porch are 3, symmetrical bays, consisting of paired 9/9 Craftsman type wood-frame windows with concrete sills, flanked by 1-light and 1-panel wood door with 2 paired 9-light Craftsman transoms. The interior, pressed-metal ceiling is intact, but the pews are gone. The side elevations have 9/9 paired, wood-frame, Craftsman-type windows with concrete sills. There is a soldier course water table and a plain cornice. The windows on the rear are 6/6 wood-frame with concrete sills.
