Brief Description:

One-and-a-half story, scored brick house with a cross-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a brick foundation. A large, centered, front-facing gable dominates the façade (N), with a circular louvered vent and two, 6/6 wood-frame windows in the upper wall and a 3-part cottage window (6/6, 16-light, 6/6) in the lower wall. To the L of the projection is an undercut, screened porch with a round-arch entry and segmental arch openings. Under the porch, a 6-light and panelled wood door is to the R of windows (obscured by screens). To the R of the projection is an 8/8 wood-frame window. All windows have concrete sills. The house has a soldier cornice and shallow, vinyl eaves. A brick chimney rests at the center ridge.
