Brief Description:

One-story, scored brick with a side-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a brick foundation. There are 2, stepped, front-facing gables on the façade (N) with paired 6/6 wood-frame windows in the larger gable end and an open, round-arch vestibule in the smaller, which is outlined in header bricks. The vestibule leads to a 6-light vertical, plank door with heavy dentil molding. To the L of the vestibule is a flat porch on brick corner posts, connected by a knee wall with concrete cap. This porch shelters a 10/10 wood-frame window and to the far R, on a recessed wall, another 10/10 wood-frame window all with concrete sills. The house has shallow, vinyl eaves and a basketweave cornice. There is a brick chimney at the ridge.

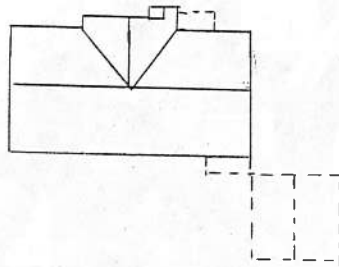
