A central, projecting wall features a 12-light awning-type, steel-framed window. To the L on the façade (N) are 2 paired, 8-light steel-frame casements and to the R are paired identical windows. The main entrance is on the side wall under an integral porch with a multi-light wood door. There is vertical wood siding under the porch.
