One-story, scored brick church with a front gable roof of asphalt shingles on a brick foundation with a soldier course water table. All windows are boarded with a Gothic arch outlined in header brick and rowlock sills. The steeple is actually an extension of the gable end wall at the center and has a Gothic arch bell opening sided in beadboard. The façade (S) has a circular, louvered vent in the gable end. There are also 3, symmetrical bays with a centered entrance, which is corbelled with a Gothic arch and is slightly recessed. This entrance is flanked by 2 windows. The side els feature concrete-capped buttresses. The E wing is a 2-story, gabled addition. There are shallow, boxed eaves.
