One-story, of scored brick with a front-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a stucco foundation. There is an exterior, stuccoed brick chimney on the N elevation. A partial-width porch, which covers the right 2/3 of the façade (E), is under a side-gable roof and wraps around to form a porte-cochere on the N elevation. All of this structure is resting on brick columns atop brick piers connected by a knee wall, all with concrete caps. The façade has 3 bays with a center 15-light wood door, which is flanked by paired windows to the right of the porch and a 3-part window under the porch. Windows are 9/1, wood-frame with concrete sills. There are vinyl boxed eaves.

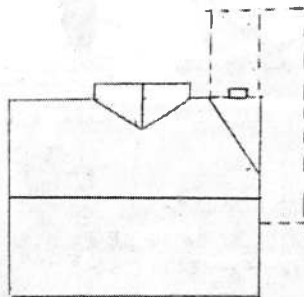
