One-story, vinyl-sided, Minimal Traditional with a cross-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a brick foundation. The façade (E) is dominated by a front-facing gable, projecting roughly centered, with a 3-part window in the wall. Recessed to the right, is the main entrance, which consists of a modern, 3-light, wood door under a metal, pent awning. To the left of the front-facing gable is an enclosed porch, now a sunroom with 6/6, metal-frame windows. The original windows are 6/6, metal-frame. A brick chimney pierces the roof at the intersection of the side-gable and the front-facing gable. There are no eaves.

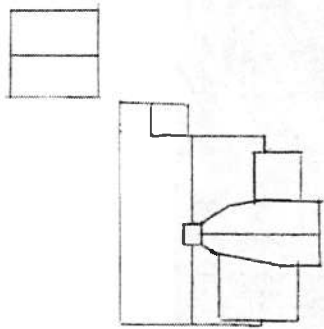
