One-and-a-half story, painted brick bungalow with a front-gable roof of painted, standing seam metal on a brick foundation. A partial-width porch, with a concrete deck, shelters the E façade under a side-gable on boxed columns. Under the porch, the centered, 6-panel, replacement door with Craftsman-type sidelights is flanked by a single window to the left and paired windows to the right. These windows are 6/6 wood-frame with rowlock sills. Large gable dormers on the N and S slopes with 3-part windows. These windows are 6/6 and 9/9 replacements.
