One-and-a-half story, scored brick with a side-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a brick foundation. 2 front-facing gables break the façade (E) into asymmetrical fenestration. A shed dormer is at the center of the front slope with paired, 9/1 wood-frame windows. The front-facing gable to the far left is the larger, and it has a flared right side with paired, 9/1 wood-frame windows in the gable end and a 9/1, tripartite window in the lower wall. To the right, is a 3-part, 1-light fixed or casement window, as well as a front-facing brick chimney with round-arch brickwork and a smaller, front-facing gable over a round-arch, wood door with a circular light. The windows on the lower walls are 6/1 wood-frame with rowlock sills and soldier lintels

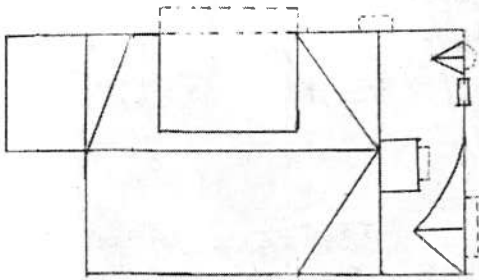
