One-and-a-half story, vinyl with a cross-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a brick foundation. 2 gable dormers pierce the front slope with 6/6 wood-frame windows. 2 brick chimneys can be seen on the rear slope. The façade (W) is 3 symmetrical bays, with a 6-panel, wood door at the center, flanked by 8/8 wood-frame windows with applied shutters. The entry has a fluted pilaster and cornice surround. Projections on the N & S elevations are recessed from the façade plane. There are shallow, boxed eaves.

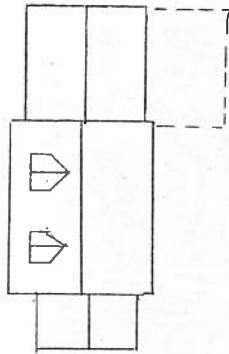
