One-story, scored brick with a cross-hip roof of asphalt shingles on a scored brick foundation. A front-facing cross-hip projects off-center on the façade (E) with 18/18 wood-frame windows in the wall. To the right is a closed vestibule under a flat roof with a 3-light, vertical plank wood door. Further right, on the main façade wall, are 18/18 wood-frame and 6/6 wood-frame windows. All have rowlock sills and pent, metal awnings. A porch on the N elevation, under a stepped hip on brick posts has been enclosed. To the left of the projecting hip is a flat-roof porch on decorative metal posts with a decorative metal balustrade. Under this porch are paired 6/6 window on the façade wall and a 3-light wood door on the side wall. There are 2 brick chimneys and no eaves.

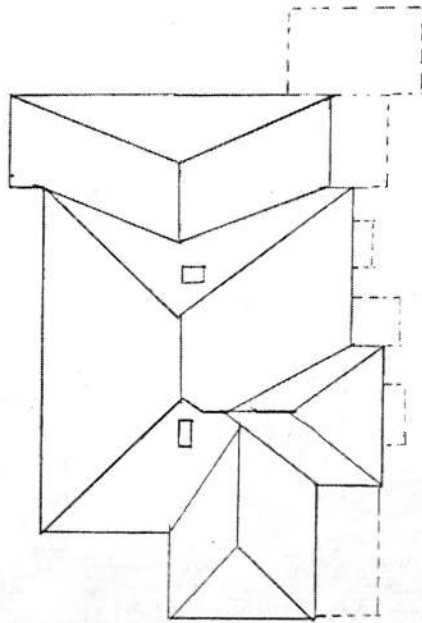
