One-story, Tudor on a corner lot with a steeply-pitched, cross-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a brick foundation. Large, front-facing gable on brick piers creates a partial-width, porch on the left side, with a smaller gable on rubble-course stone with a round-arch entry outlined in rowlock brick to the immediate right, roughly at the center of the façade (E). A stone chimney with brick upper is to the right of the entrance facing forward on the façade. The windows are Craftsman-type 9/1 wood-frame with concrete sills. The entrance is a segmental arched, vertical plank, wood door with paired windows to each side of the façade. There are boxed eaves.

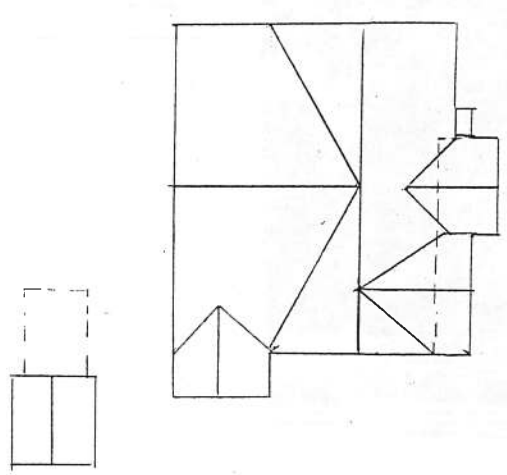
