One-and-a-half story, vinyl sided with a side-gable roof of modern standing seam metal on an obscured foundation. A large, shed dormer is centered on the front slope with four 6/6 metal-frame (or vinyl-clad) windows. A full-width porch on the façade (E) is sheltered by a shed, secondary slope, which is supported by panelled, boxed columns. Under the porch are 3 asymmetrical bays of a 12-light wood door with a 4-light transom. The entrance is flanked by a 16/16 metal-frame (or vinyl) window on the left and a 3-part, (8/8, 16/16, 8/8) window to the right. The house also has an exterior brick chimney on the N elevation and boxed, vinyl eaves.

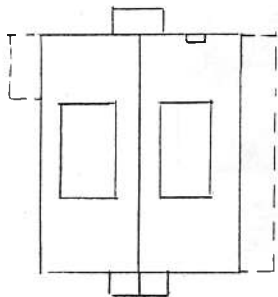
