Brief Description:

One-story, textured brick church, of a traditional T-plan with a front-gable of modern, raised seam metal, with a small wooden steeple on a brick foundation. An central entrance on the E façade is on a slight wall projection and is sheltered under a front-gable porch, which is supported by tapered wood columns. The entrance consists of 2-light and 4-panel wood doors with a blind, Gothic arch above. Flanking the porch are two, 1/1 wood-frame windows with concrete sills. The building appears to have been rebricked c. 1950. There are boxed, vinyl eaves.

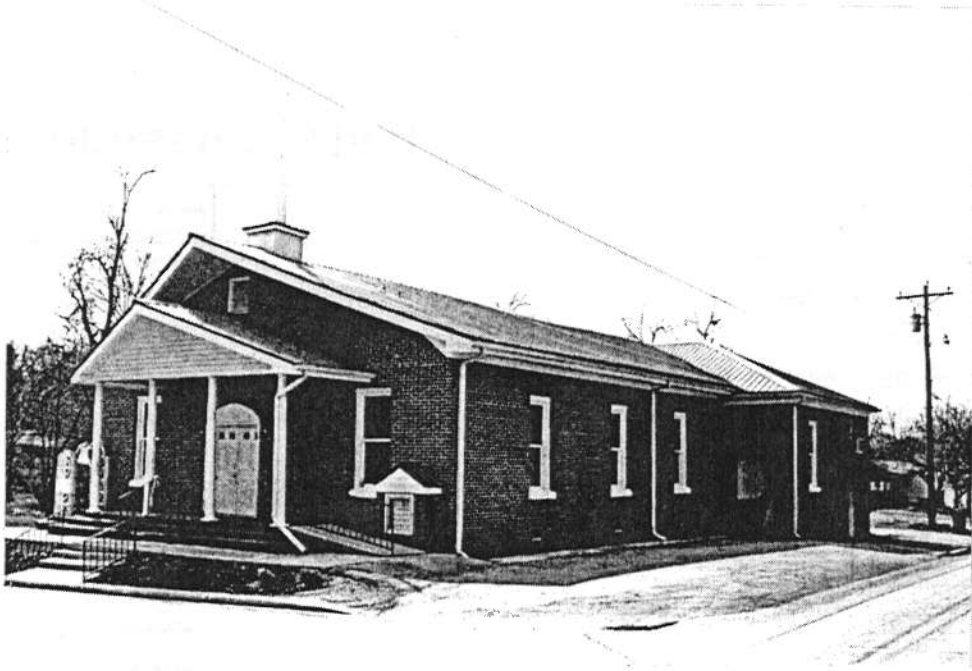

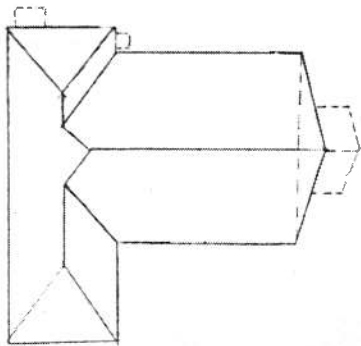
