One-story, narrow clapboard or O-G bungalow with a front-gable roof of asphalt shingles on a painted brick foundation. There are two 6-light wood-frame windows and asbestos shingles in the gable end. A side-gabled porch shelters the left two-thirds of the façade (W), wrapping around to the N elevation, and resting on battered boxed columns atop brick piers with concrete caps. The façade has 3 symmetrical bays, with a 15-light centered, wood door flanked by paired 9/1 wood-frame windows. There are exposed rafters and 2 interior brick chimneys.

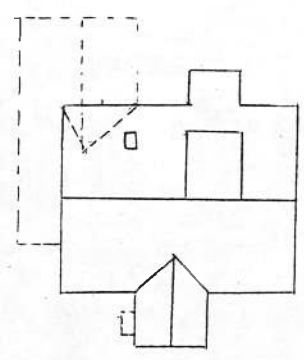
